Winter warnings

During the winter festive period there maybe situations your dogs are not comfortable in. It is important to let them have their own space, be it a crate or a spare room to quiet down in. Practice impulse control training well in advance before the big meal!

Foods your dog cannot eat

- Onions
- Chives
- Chocolate
- Macadamia nuts
- Corn on the cob
- Avocado
- Xylitol artificial sweeteners
- Alcohol
- Cooked bones
- Grapes and raisins

If you dog has consumed even the smallest amount of these items please contact your vet immediately.

We in the UK also have an animal poison line which was started in 2017, it is a 24hour service.

Calls cost £30 per case, payable by credit card at the time of the call. If an animal does require treatment and the vet subsequently calls the professional line (Veterinary Poisons Information Service) for detailed treatment advice, Animal PoisonLine will refund the £30 to the owner.
